Challenges for Regional Science Research: Past and Present

Robert J. Stimson will present an overview of the challenges, past and present, faced by regional science, discussing how regional science has dealt with past critiques of its relevance, the contemporary big issues being addresses by regional scientists, and propose future directions for regional science research.

Stimson is an analytical human geographer and regional scientist. He has been conducting spatial research in a number of universities in Australia for 49 years.
